

Super Bowl Party

The football season is not over yet even though the Green Bay Packers and Chicago Bears aren't going to the Super Bowl. So, why not try something different when planning your Super Bowl party this year. These simple tips will wow your guests. Purchase a 12 foot by 12 inch piece of artificial grass from your local lumber store. It usually costs less than \$4.00, and you can do so much with it.



Astro-Turf Coasters and Can Cozies

Cut out 4" x 4" squares to make coasters. The rubber backing is easy to cut through if you use a utility knife instead of scissors. Glue a piece of cardboard to the back to make them more durable.



To make the can cozies, cut a piece 3" x 10" and tape the ends together. It will slip easily on any can and any heavy duty tape will work.





Napkin Ring

Napkin rings are made the same way just smaller. You'll need a 1 ¹/₁₂" x 5 ¹/₂" strip. Use tape to hold it together.



Table Runners and Placemats

Fake grass is also great for table runners and placemats. Cut whatever length is appropriate for your table to use as a runner. For placemats, I cut a piece 12" x 16" piece.





Football Field

If you want to be really authentic, paint yard lines on your runner. White craft paint and a paint brush is all you need. A stencil brush with a flat end works best.
