

## Egg-ceptional Easter Table

It doesn't matter if you serve brunch or dinner at Easter—welcome the Easter bunny with a colorful table setting. My friend Cori invited us into her home to set our seasonal tables in her lovely dining room.



Wake up Easter morning to hot pink and lime green! This fuchsia table top is really a nubby, sheer curtain over a basic white cloth. I always head for the linen section of the store when I shop at Goodwill. This \$6.99 investment became the inspiration for the rest of the table.



Then I went for contrast using a basic white dinner plate with green border.



Add a lime green bowl (from a different set of dishes, but a perfect match) to keep the contrast going.



I wrapped a bit of pink grosgrain ribbon around a folded napkin for added punch. A single floral stem makes the place setting personal. Even the stripe tumblers coordinate with the table!



No need for a bouquet of flowers when you use your decorated eggs for the centerpiece. This little bunny wheelbarrow is a cute alternative to a traditional Easter basket.



Finish the table with a couple of candles and scatter glass pebble "confetti" around the table and your guests will ohh and ah over your creativity!
