You already know that you can get frames in all shapes and sizes at Goodwill; everything from contemporary to vintage, wood, metal, acrylic and everything in between.



Add the year or school or student's name to any photo with magazine cut-outs and some glue!



Since I wanted to use 2010, I clipped numbers out of magazine articles and ads.



Be sure to pay attention to size, scale and color. However, you don't have to make perfect cuts.



I love decoupage glue because it's so easy to use and dries quickly and clear. I laid out 2010 on colored paper (also from a magazine) and glued the numbers down.

You can attach the commemorative year to the glass, the frame or the picture.

It only took a few minutes to create a personalized and customized keepsake for the proud grad!
