

## Knock Knock

The basic round door knob may become a thing of the past some day. Many new homes are incorporating "universal design" elements. As baby boomers get older, there will be a greater need for wider doorways to allow for wheelchairs and walkers. Lever handles are replacing door knobs so everyone can open and close doors regardless of their abilities or disabilities.



Old glass knobs have their own vintage charm so I had to find some way to use them. Add a bit of wire and they are perfect as a photo stand or place card holder.



I collected assorted knobs and found a roll of old wire. I like the rust, but you can use new wire from the hardware store.



Push the wire through the hole on top and through the side hole and wrap around the base a few times until the wire will stand up.



Be creative when bending the wire. The final result should have an organic feel. Twist the end in a couple of circles to hold pictures in place.



The stands are perfect for old or new photos and make a unique place card holder for your next dinner party.
