

2020 Goodwill DIY Halloween Contest

Who Can Enter:

- Contestants must be legal residents of Southeastern Wisconsin (Counties: Milwaukee, Waukesha, Fond du Lac, Rock, Dodge, Walworth, Washington, Sheboygan, Ozaukee, Green Lake, Jefferson, Racine & Kenosha) or Metropolitan Chicago (Counties: Lake, DuPage, Cook, Kane, Iroquois, Kankakee, Ford, Vermilion, Kendall & Will).
- Employees of Goodwill Industries of Southeastern Wisconsin and Metropolitan Chicago ("Sponsor"), and the immediate family members of those employees are ineligible.

How You'll Enter:

- Show off your creativity, by using items from Goodwill in your Halloween creation. Purchase items from Goodwill Industries of southeastern Wisconsin and metropolitan Chicago and use them to create your Halloween costume (photos only, no videos please).
- In order to be considered, at least 50% of your Halloween costume must come from Goodwill. On your photo's caption, don't forget to tell voters which items from Goodwill were used to make your costume!
- Your creation must be original and not purchased as a prepackaged costume.
Eligible photos must be submitted between noon on October 1, 2020 and 11:59 p.m. on October 22, 2020.
- Choose **ONE** of the entry methods below and follow the instructions for the method you choose. Entries will not be accepted until the contest begins on October 1, 2020. Any entries given before or after the submission timeframe will not be accepted.
- An entry form will appear on the main contest page (<https://www.amazinggoodwill.com/halloween-costume-contest-2020>), beginning on October 1, 2020 at Noon. To enter, you'll need to fill in your full name, address and email, along with a short description of your costume; describing the materials you used and the finished product. Along with your information, you will also attach one photo of your completed project. JPEG and PNG files will be accepted. **Please keep your descriptions short, in order to ensure your photo is fully visible once the voting round begins.**

Rules & Guidelines:

- **One entry per person; if you submit multiple entries, Goodwill reserves the right to pick which of your entries will move on for voting.**
- A single photo should be submitted as a .jpeg or .png file to ensure successful upload. Only these file types are supported by the system.
- Photos, and items created, need to remain tasteful; anything deemed otherwise may not be eligible for voting. Goodwill Industries reserves the right not to allow a photo through if, in its sole discretion, is deemed inappropriate.
- The Top 10 entries, chosen by a Goodwill panel of judges, will move on to the final round of voting.
- Fan voting will choose our winners. Details below.

Voting:

- Fan Voting will run October 26 – October 31 at 11:59 p.m., 2020.
- The voting tab will become active on October 26, 2020.
- To vote for a photo, you'll select "vote" beneath the specific photo.
- Each person may only cast their vote once per entry, per day, per IP Address. This means that if you are voting in an office setting, under the same IP Address, you will only be able to vote on a specific item one time during that day. Because of this, voting from home is highly recommended.
- We recommend casting one vote total per day. Be sure to look through all the entries before deciding on your favorite.
- The Top 10 entries are judged based on difficulty, uniqueness and creative use of items
- The winner will be announced on AmazingGoodwill.com on November 3, 2020.
